

RESOLUTION NO. 963

CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR A WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM (WWRP) PROJECT TO THE RECREATION AND CONSERVATION OFFICE (RCO) AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 79A.15RCW, ACQUISITION OF HABITAT CONSERVATION AND OUTDOOR RECREATION LANDS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lacey, has approved a “Comprehensive Plan for Outdoor Recreation” which describes, in part, the need to acquire lands in the Pleasant Glade Planning Area and the Hawk’s Prairie Planning area for a community park, and to acquire lands along Woodland Creek for wildlife habitat and conservation; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program, state funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the acquisition of land for parks and habitat conservation areas and the acquisition and construction of outdoor recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lacey considers it in the best public interest to acquire the Pleasant Glade Community Park lands; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON as follows:

1. That the City Manager be authorized to make formal application to the Recreation and Conservation Office for funding assistance for the Pleasant Glade Community Park Acquisition Project.
2. That any funding assistance so received shall be used to pay costs associated with the acquisition of the Pleasant Glade Community Park Acquisition Project.
3. That the City Manager be authorized to enter into agreement with the Recreation and Conservation Office for any funding assistance so received.
4. That the City’s share of the cost of such project will be derived from the budgeted funds of the City, including donations and other sources of grant funding.
5. The City of Lacey does hereby certify that the City is responsible to support all non-cash commitments to the local share should they not materialize.

6. Any lands acquired with such financial aid through the Recreation and Conservation Office shall be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Recreation and Conservation Office, and any affected federal agency.
7. That this Resolution becomes part of a formal application to the Recreation and Conservation Office.
8. That adequate notification has been given and the opportunity provided for public comment on this application.
