A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON,
SUPPORTING A COMPASSIONATE COMMUNITY PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Lacey recognizes the importance and critical nature of Thurston County Food Bank's mission in response to hunger and access to food within the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON:

SECTION 1. The Council hereby supports Thurston County Food Bank's plan to create a Lacey Food Bank and declares this initiative as a Compassionate Community Project.

SECTION 2. The Council hereby supports the continued collaboration of North Thurston Public Schools and the Lacey South Sound Chamber in realizing the establishment of the Lacey Food Bank.
