

RESOLUTION NO. 1052

CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY IN SUPPORT OF LACEY FIRE DISTRICT 3 PROPOSITION 1 – BONDS FOR FIRE STATIONS, VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, Lacey Fire Protection District No. 3 Proposition No. 1 – Bonds for Fire Stations, Vehicles and Equipment (“Proposition 1”) will be presented to the voters of the district at the general election to be held on November 2, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1 would authorize the District to issue no more than \$19,975,147 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds; and

WHEREAS, the District's current levy rate is inadequate to support continuing levels of service; and

WHEREAS, new revenues would be used to construct a new Station 34 and convert the existing Station 34 into a training facility; construct additions to Station 33 and the Vehicle Repair Facility; renovate Station 35; acquire firefighting and emergency medical service vehicles and equipment and make other capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1 would have a direct economic and substantive impact on the Lacey community and is of importance and interest to a broad cross-section of Lacey residents; and

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2017, the City Council held a public meeting pursuant to the provisions of RCW42.17A.555(1), at which members of the public were afforded an equal opportunity for the expression of an opposing view of Proposition 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the City Council is in support of Lacey Fire District 3 Proposition 1 – Bonds for Fire Stations, Vehicles and Equipment, and encourages voters to approve this Proposition on November 7, 2017.
