

RESOLUTION NO. 967

CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY'S PROPOSED SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM AND OTHER PLANNING CONCEPTS FOR SUBMITTAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City has, after public hearing and consideration of comments of agencies and citizens, adopted findings and conclusions and recommended to the City Council approval of a Draft City of Lacey Shoreline Master Program dated July 7, 2010, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Shoreline Master Program cannot be formally adopted by the City until it is approved by the State Department of Ecology, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has also recommended to the Council approval of provisions regarding a shoreline overlay, incentives in the development of land, an innovative techniques section for the Land Use Plan and recommended for approval amendments to the City's Development Guidelines and Public Works Standards and said recommendations need to be considered for final adoption as part of the final adoption of the Shoreline Master Program,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the Council hereby adopts those certain Planning Commission Findings and Conclusions for Adoption of the Draft Shoreline Master Program dated July 6, 2010, and that certain document entitled City of Lacey Shoreline Master Program dated July 7, 2010 including associated proposed amendments to the regulatory ordinances and guidelines of the City contained within said draft document and that said plan and planning concepts be submitted to the Washington State Department of Ecology for approval prior to formal adoption by the City Council.
