HOW DOES IT WORK?

Groups can borrow 1-10 panels for up to one week at a time, through July 2017. (After this date, the duration is negotiable.)

Note: Full exhibit includes 10 panels, each measuring 79" H x 32 1/2" W x 16" D. 30 linear feet of floor space is needed for the full exhibit.

WHAT DO THE PANELS COVER?



Panel 1: **The Early Years**--Highlights important stories of the Lacey area in the pre-incorporation years.

Panels 2-3: **Becoming A City**--Tells the story of rivalry and intrigue that eventually led to the formation of the City of Lacey.

Panel 4: **Our City Grows**--How Lacey developed in its early years.

Panel 5: **Commitment to Citizens**--How the City of Lacey has been at the forefront of service to its community with many firsts.

Panel 6: **Educating All Ages**--How Saint Martin's University, North Thurston School District, and South Puget Sound Community College helped shape our community

Panel 7-8: **Enriching Pastimes**--Lacey's rich quality of life takes many forms: natural beauty, community events, and service to others – just to name a few.

Panel 9: **A Home For All**--Lacey has become well known for its welcoming attitude to a diverse population.

Panel 10: **Through the Years**- A map of Lacey's growth in area and population.
