- **The City of Lacey is hosting our 4th Annual S.T.E.M. Fair.** This REGIONAL event is slated for May 20th, our aim is to attract people from throughout Thurston County and beyond and we are hoping you will join us. We are also including SKILLS, to include the trades that make STEM work.

- **A little history:** Since 1998 Lacey has hosted the Lacey Grand Prix Electric Car Rally (Electrathon America sanctioned event) along with the Alternative Energy Fair at Huntamer Park in the heart of Lacey. The event no longer hosts the Lacey Grand Prix, but has expanded to STEM Fair, with focus to include displays, hands on activities for kids, and demonstrations as well as businesses with a focus on STEM. *In 2015 this event received the Program Excellence Spotlight Award for Innovating Programming from the Washington Recreation and Parks Assoc.*
- **STEM = opportunity.** STEM isn't just for scientists and engineers. Washington's economy is rooted in STEM. It's simple: in the 21st century, STEM opens doors for every student to succeed. **We're facing a STEM shortage.** In the past ten years, STEM jobs have grown three times faster than non-STEM jobs. Yet too few of our students see STEM's power or possibilities. **It's time to shift STEM into high gear.** Right now, we have an unprecedented window of opportunity to reimagine STEM education.
