Application Form

You may be eligible to replace up to **two** of your toilets with High-Efficiency Toilets (HETs). HETs are a new generation of toilets that use 60% less water than the older, high flow toilets. Lacey pays for the toilet(s); you pay for the installation by a plumber of your choice or install it yourself. We are offering three different toilet models – you choose the one that will best meet your needs.

To be eligible, you must:

- Install the toilet(s) in a residence that currently receives City of Lacey water service on septic
- Replace the existing toilet(s) that use 3.0 gallons or more per flush
- Complete this application, including proof of toilet size.
Proof of toilet size may come from proof of original purchase or you may measure your toilet using the last page in this application. If you are unable to measure your toilet, a city employee can assist you with measure your toilet. Contact Lacey Water Resources at 360-486-8707 to request assistance with measure your toilet.
- Attach a copy of your City utility bill showing your account number
➔ NOTE: incomplete applications will not be accepted

Applications will be processed once per month, during the first week of the month.

If your application has been approved, the City of Lacey will send you a voucher(s) for the toilet(s) requested which will include instructions for picking up your new toilet(s).

Due to variables beyond our control, the City of Lacey makes no guarantee of the High-Efficiency Toilet (HET) performance or related water savings.
6. The City of Lacey is not responsible for damage that might occur to Participant's property as a result of participation in the program. Participant hereby agrees by signing this agreement to hold harmless the City of Lacey against any liability arising out of this agreement.

Toilet Measurement Form

Instructions

Please fill in the table below, taking measurements for each of the toilets you wish to replace through this program. See the photo for reference.

If your toilet is marked with a stamp of “1.6 gpf” your toilet is considered “low-flow”, and will not qualify for this program, so further measurements are not necessary. If your toilet is not stamped, remove the lid from the toilet tank and take the following measurements inside the tank, resting the metal tab of the tape measure against the inside edge of tank. **All measurements should be in inches.**

1. **Length** – Measure the inside of the tank side to side. (If tank is not uniformly rectangular, provide an average of the lengths near the top of the water line and at the bottom.)
2. **Width** – Measure the inside of the toilet tank front to back.
3. **Depth 1** – Set the metal end of the measuring tape down at the bottom of the tank to record the height of the water present when the tank is full.
4. **Depth 2** – Keeping the measuring tape in the same position (metal end at the tank bottom), flush the toilet. Record the inches of water when the tank is at its lowest.
